Advanced Placement, Experiential Learning, & Articulation Agreements

The Medical Assisting Program follows Georgia Northwestern Technical College's policy on Advanced Placement and Experiential Learning for core/pre-occupational classes. GNTC offers many articulation agreements with other college systems upon admission to the school.

Currently No MAST prefixed courses are available for Advanced Placement, Experiential Learning, or transfer of credit into the Diploma Medical Assisting. No MAST prefixed courses are allowed transferred in from other institutions for credit of these occupational classes, only general education classes.

The Medical Assisting program will allow Prior Learning Assessment from GNTCs Economic Development Back Office Tech program in lieu of MAST 1080. The objectives and competencies have been cross walked and are equivalent to MAST 1080.

The Medical Assisting Diploma program is a for credit pathway and therefore students can receive college credit transfers to other institutions based on the accepting college's policy for credit. Official transcripts can be obtained from the Registrar.
